Paper Heart Valentines





Create stunning handmade Frozen heart cards

- bowl (smaller than square origami paper)
- origami paper
- 2 pieces of 8.5"x11" cardstock
- glue scissors pencil
- foam pop dots printer

Let's Start!


- 1. Trace a circle onto the square paper (origami paper shown is 5.9"x5.9") using a pencil.
- 2. Cut the circle out.
- 3. Fold circle in half. Unfold.
- 4. Fold circle in half the other way. Unfold.
- 5. Fold both sides to the center line. Unfold.
- 6. Fold one side to the opposite crease.



- 7. Fold the other side to the opposite crease.
- 8. Unfold.
- 9. Fold the left side to the first crease. Fold the right side to the first crease.
- 10. Make a small fold to the previous fold.
- 11. Repeat folding as pictured.
- 12. Every other fold will already be there.
- 13. Keep folding all the way until you get to the end.
- 14. Hold in the middle and fold in half.









- 15. Add glue to the center of the heart.
- 16. Hold it together for a few seconds to set.
- 17. Take the 8.5"x11" piece of paper and trim length wise so it measures 4.25x11". That is the card base. Glue the heart onto the front of the card.
- 18. Print the banner using white cardstock or regular paper and cut out.
- 19. Peel and stick a pop dot onto each end of the banner. Stick onto the front of the card.
- 20. Write a sentiment inside and give the card to someone special!
