What Happened On 9/11?



On September 11, 2001, something very sad and scary happened in the United States. Early that morning, four airplanes were taken over by bad people called terrorists.

At 8:46 AM, the first airplane crashed into a tall building called the North Tower in New York City. A second airplane hit the South Tower at 9:03 AM.

The 3rd airplane crashed into the Pentagon, where the headquarters of the U.S. Department of Defense is located.

The fourth airplane, Flight 93, was also taken over, but the brave passengers fought back and stopped it from reaching another building, causing it to crash in a field in Pennsylvania.

Sadly, almost 3,000 people lost their lives that day, including many firefighters and police officers who tried to help.

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What Happened On 9/11?

Even though that day was very sad, many heroes showed great bravery. Firefighters, police officers, doctors, the military, and regular people rushed in to help those in danger.

Now, September 11 is a day to remember those who were lost and to encourage everyone to be kind to one another.

There are special places, like the National September 11 Memorial & Museum, where people can remember the victims and learn about the importance of being nice and understanding each other.

Learning about 9/11 helps us appreciate the brave people who helped and inspires us to spread kindness in our own lives.

Write a short paragraph about what being a hero means to you. Who do you think is a hero in your life?




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How Can You Help Others?

Draw a picture and write a short paragraph on ways can you help people, like the heroes did, on 9/11?



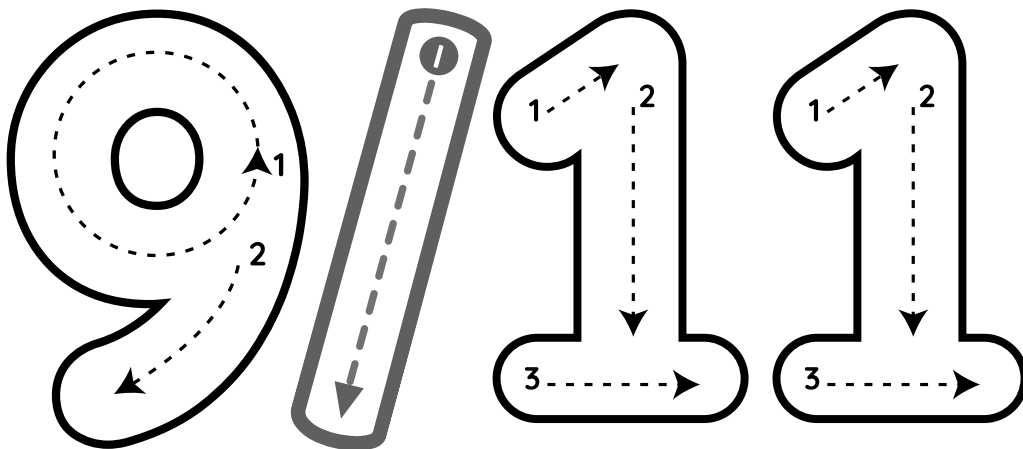
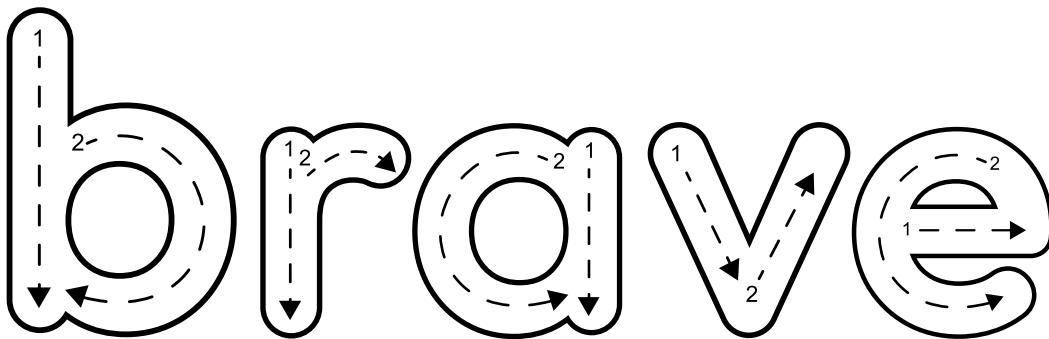
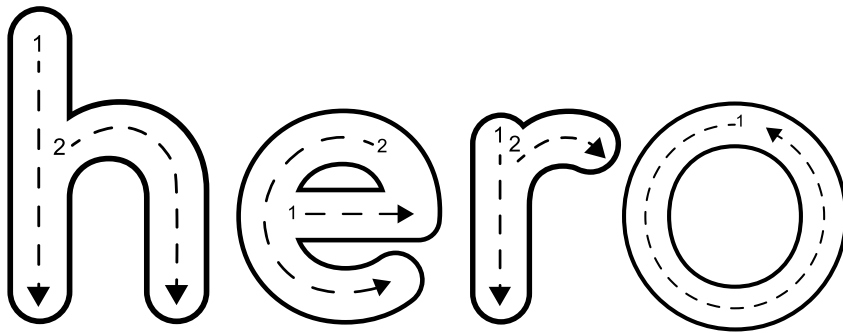
